

Information for contributors

Ethnologia Fennica publishes original scholarly articles, review articles, congress reports and book reviews that promote Finnish ethnological research. The languages of the journal are English and German. British and American English can both be used, but consistently. The views expressed are those of the authors and not necessarily those of the journal.

Manuscripts to the article section may not exceed 10 000 words. The places of photos, figures, and tables should be clearly marked in the text. Titles to the tables and legends to the photos and figures should be written in a separate file and clearly numbered. Credits of the photos should be stated at the end of the legend. A short list of keywords should also be included.

Manuscripts to the review section preferably should not exceed 1500 words. Book reviews should include a headline and full details of the reviewed book.

All manuscripts should have line spacing 1,5 and they should be submitted by e-mail; manuscripts of articles to the editor-in-chief, book reviews and other texts to the subeditor. Do not format the text unless words which need to be italicized. It is important that the author has the final manuscript version language checked by a professional. Authors should make certain that their contact information (name, title, address, institutional affiliation and e-mail address) in English is given with their materials.

References to literature are placed in parenthesis at the relevant point in the text (Ruotsala 2002, 18). Notes should be used for clarification and discussion, and be placed at the end of the article. The list of references or bibliography must be complete. Details should be presented as follows:
